Koh Phing Kan & Koh Tapu (James Bond Island)

Arguably the most famous spot in the bay, it's been a Mecca for Thai and Western tourist for 4 decades. Be the first one there with Club Champagne Phuket.

Cave Exploring

Panak Island is often our first stop for some intriguing cave exploration. Like Swiss cheese, Panak is full of hidden caves, lagoons and hongs.

Sea Canoeing

Tam Lod Nai is a stunning location for a scenic canoe trip. They are simply the best way to see these geological wonders up close and personal. Let the Thai guide take you into hongs and caves only accessible by canoe.

Panyee Village

The village on stilts, originally a settlement by nomadic Malay fisherman 200 years ago.

Treasure Island

Just a few minutes from James Bond lays a fantastic hidden cave, only accessible by swimming through a narrow passage. Jump off the front of the boat, swim to the beach and cool off before we move across the bay.

Koh Yao Yai

We take a short trip across the north of the island to a stunning local Thai restaurant for lunch.

Tropical Beach

The afternoon will take us to any number of beautiful beaches depending on tide and weather conditions. This is a chance to swim of or relax on a deserted beach.
